

We request that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) or its agents consult directly with DHR, as necessary, pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (as amended) and its implementing regulations codified at 36 CFR Part 800 which require Federal agencies to consider the effects of their undertakings on historic properties.

We are unable to comment on the acceptability of the project until consultation with the Corps is complete.
