The change in location can be handled via a minor modification provided that there is no increase in impacts, as explained by VWP Regulation 9VAC25-210-180F. The locations of the raw water alignment options displayed in the maps attached to your email are outside of the limits of the wetland delineation study area shown by the impact area plans identified by Part I.A.3 of your permit and by the Jurisdictional Delineation section of JPA 14-0343. A new Jurisdictional Delineation will need to be conducted and confirmed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers prior to submission of a request for a minor modification if the raw water transmission line locations are proposed to be moved outside of these limits.

The request for a minor modification will need to include documentation that the changes will result in no increase in impacts beyond the amount previously authorized by the permit.
