

This will further respond to your past letter or email wherein you note your objection to the above-referenced project. Specifically, the James River Water Authority seeks Commission authorization to install a submerged water line beneath the Rivanna River and a raw water intake along the north bank of the James River, near the Town of Columbia, in Fluvanna County.

Please be advised that we received revised project drawings (attached) on March 2, 2016, shifting the proposed intake upstream to the property of Dr. William R. Hammond. We additionally received, on November 23, 2015, a copy of the Department of Environmental Quality's Virginia Water Protection (VWP) Individual Permit.

In light of DEQ's approval of this project and the recent shift in the intake alignment, I feel it necessary to ascertain whether or not you continue to object to the project as revised. Upon review, I would respectfully request that you notify us in writing by March 25, 2016, if you object to the project as modified. Should we fail to receive such notification, we will assume that you no longer oppose the project.
